

ST. JOHNS COUNTY 4-H FASHION REVUE 2017

All 4-H'ers who have sewn a garment over this past year are encouraged to take part in the 4-H Fashion Revue. This event happens in several different stages, so please read the following information carefully and be sure to call the 4-H office if you have questions.

IMPORTANT DATES FOR THE 4-H FASHION REVUE PARTICIPANTS:

- **Fashion Revue Event Registration Form that includes a photo of them wearing their outfit, and their personally sewn garment on Monday, April 3rd by 5:00 pm** to the St. Johns County 4-H Office.
- **Fashion Interviews will take place on Wednesday, April 5th between 4:00 pm and 6:00 pm** at the St. Johns County Extension Office. (Sign up for a 5-minute interview session by calling the St. Johns County 4-H Office 904-209-0430 and press "2" for the 4-H Office.)
- **Fashion Revue will take place on Thursday, April 6th at 6:00 pm** at the St. Johns County Extension Office.

GENERAL RULES:

- Members must submit a **Fashion Revue Event Registration Form that includes a photo of them wearing their outfit, and their personally sewn garment on Monday, April 3rd by 5:00 pm** to the St. Johns County 4-H Office.
- The **script** included on the registration form, must also **be emailed to kcanderson@sjcfl.us by Monday, April 3rd**.
- Members may only enter **one outfit**. The outfit must be created, coordinated and modeled by the 4-H member participant.
- Outfits are subject to review for modesty and appropriate attire. Formal wear may be strapless or have spaghetti straps. No backless dresses, excessive visible cleavage, visible undergarments, lingerie or swim suits. Please follow 4-H dress code.
- Members will be **judged on their modeling and interview skills on Wednesday, April 5th between 4:00 pm and 6:00 pm**. Youth must **sign up for a 5-minute interview session by calling the St. Johns County 4-H Office 904-209-0430** and press "2" for the 4-H Office.
- **Fashion Revue ribbons will be awarded** the night of the Fashion Revue on **Thursday, April 6th at 6:00 pm** at the St. Johns County Extension Office.
- This year all youth entries will be under the Personally Sewn category.

The following criteria will be used during the modeling and interview process on Wednesday, April 5th between 4:00 pm and 6:00 pm:

Project Knowledge.....	50%
Experiences and accomplishments through 4-H activities.....	25%
Interview Skills.....	25%

Possible questions that could be asked during the interview session on Wednesday, April 5th between 4:00 pm and 6:00 pm:

- Why did you choose the clothing project?
- What was one of your goals for the year relating to this project?
- How does the outfit you chose express your personality?
- How is the color, fabric, style, or fit of this garment/outfit a good choice for your size, or your body shape?
- Why do you think the fabric is a good choice for the garment design and features?
- How does this garment/outfit show/reflect current fashion trends?
- In what way did the design elements and principles found in this garment/outfit help you to choose this garment/outfit?
- What occasions, purposes, or activities did you have in mind when you selected or constructed this garment/outfit? Why do you think this garment is appropriate for this occasion, purpose, or activity?
- What functional characteristics did you want in your garment/outfit and how does this garment/outfit match your intent?
- How do the accessories you have chosen add to your overall appearance?
- How much did it cost you to make this this garment/outfit?
- Explain how this garment/outfit and the accessories you have chosen mix with or enhance and expand your wardrobe?
