✍ Read through this camp brochure as soon as it is received...camps have limited enrollment and they fill up fast!

✍ Youth not currently enrolled in 4-H (or who have enrolled after March 1, 2017) are welcomed to register on or after May 5th 2017.

✍ 4-H Age is determined by how old campers were on September 1, 2016, NOT their age at the time of the camp.

✍ Eligible 4-H members will need to go to the EVENTBRITE links and register online. Payment can be made online or a check can be mailed to the 4-H within 5 days of online registration. Campers are not registered until payment has been received by the 4-H Office. Camps will be open to non-4-Her on Friday, **MAY 5, 2017.**

✍ Full refunds will be given if notice of cancellation is provided at least TWO weeks prior to the first day of the camp (Refunds do NOT include Clover Award monies).

✍ Unless noted, all camps are held at the **St. Johns County Extension Office or Wind Mitigation Building. Some camps include fieldtrips.**

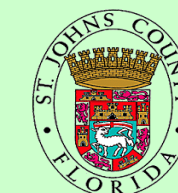
