Commercial fertilizer applicators are required to have a license from the Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services (FDACS). In order to apply for this license, each Green Industry worker must first be trained in the GI-BMPs and receive a certificate of completion from UF/IFAS and FDEP. GI-BMP training provides education on how to reduce non-point source pollution from fertilizers and pesticides. UF/IFAS Extension St. Johns County will offer this class on Tuesday, July 25, 2017, from 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. at the Wind Mitigation Building; 3111 Agriculture Center Drive; St. Augustine, FL.
