

PROCEDURE

1. Fill out form on **Reverse Side**.
2. All parties must have signed at the appropriate places on Reverse Side.
3. If horse is **Leased – Form 4-H 514** has been filled out and turned in to the 4-H Office.
4. Turn in paperwork to 4-H office by **December 31st of current year**.

REQUIREMENTS

1. Must be an active and current 4-H club member – meeting all the membership requirements established by the club and county program.
2. Manage at least one horse of any age or breed as a 4-H Horse Project. No more than (3) three horses can be on file per 4-H'er.
3. Forms must be submitted to the 4-H office by ***December 31st of the current year.***
4. Counties may allow for replacement of a project horse or pony that is not registered prior to the Area Show if, the project horse or pony is certified unsound by a veterinarian and approved by the County Extension Agent and 4-H leader.
5. The 4-H member must keep and submit to the county agent a 4-H project record on project horse.
